Title: Support for House Bill 317 Traffic Control Devices Near Schools

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 29,000 tribal citizens; and

WHEREAS, students often walk to school and there is not appropriate signage for cars to slow down; and


WHEREAS, there is currently a bill in the Alaska State Legislature that is addressing the issue of safety for our school-aged children; and

WHEREAS, House Bill No. 317 - Traffic Control Devices Near Schools, adequately addresses the concerns of requiring school zone signs, reduced speed limits, and flashing lights for the safety of students.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Seventy-Ninth Tribal Assembly of Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened in Juneau, Alaska on April 9-12, 2014, hereby supports and encourages the passage of House Bill 317, Traffic Control Devices Near Schools.
