Resolution TA/ 15-13

Title: Request Tlingit-Haida Regional Housing Authority to Re-Evaluate Income Used for
Rental Rates

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) is a federally recognized tribe with nearly 30,000 tribal citizens; and

WHEREAS, tenants monthly rent is calculated using child support (even if it isn't being collected); and

WHEREAS, tenants struggle to save money in order to become home owners (rent is increased every time they receive a raise, but not every time they are unexpectedly unemployed).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Eightieth Tribal Assembly of Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened in Juneau, Alaska on April 15-17, 2015, hereby request Tlingit Haida Regional Housing Authority (THRHA) to reconsider the income included for the Low Income Housing rental program, and do not include child support or disability payments for children to determine the monthly rental rates; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, request THRHA to cap the percentage of income included in calculating rent from 30% to 20%, in order to allow working families to save money to become home owners.

ADOPTED this 16th day of April 2015, by the Eightieth Tribal Assembly of Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska.
