Resolution TA/ 15-14

Title: Require Metal Detectors at the Mental Health Residences and Facilities

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) is a federally recognized tribe with nearly 30,000 tribal citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Tribes of Tlingit and Haida Indians of Alaska is a federally recognized tribe with more than 2,900 tribal citizens; and

WHEREAS, to provide protection and safety of the mental health clients, who have been shown statistically to be victims of dangerous and deadly violent crimes; and

WHEREAS, to help ensure safety and healthy working environment for all employees and staff at residences and facilities, and protection for the public.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Eightieth Tribal Assembly of the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened in Juneau, Alaska on April 15-17, 2015, hereby support the requirement of metal detectors at the mental health residents and facilities;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, to ensure the protection of the mental health clients, their families and staff/employee, property owners are required to maintain metal detectors at the above mentioned living residences and facilities; and


BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, for security reasons, property owners of said residences, be required to maintain 24 hour recording surveillance equipment of all property of above mentioned residences and facilities.
