Resolution TA/ 16-07

Title: Donated Subsistence/ Sport Fish and Seafood in School Lunch Programs

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 30,000 tribal citizens; and

WHEREAS, The State of Alaska's "Nutritional Alaska Foods in Schools" Grant that allowed for purchase of Alaska fish/ seafood has ended; and

WHEREAS, School Food Service Programs generally run a budget deficit, which often result in closing lunch programs due to shrinking budgets; and

WHEREAS, subsistence/ sport wild game meat can be donated to schools; and

WHEREAS, not all commercial fishermen can afford to donate fish/ seafood to a non-profit or school every season; and

WHEREAS, communities value and rely upon locally caught fish and seafood to feed their families, and would like to see them continue to stay in school lunch programs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Eighty-First Tribal Assembly of Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened in Juneau, Alaska on April 20-22, 2016, hereby respectfully requests the State of Alaska to revise regulations to allow sport/ subsistence caught fish and seafood to be donated to schools or Head Start for their lunch programs.


