Resolution EC/ 14-09

Title: Authority to Apply for NAGPRA Funds

WHEREAS, Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) is a federally recognized tribe of more than 29,000 tribal citizens worldwide; and

WHEREAS, the National Park Service (NPS) has announced the availability of FY 2014 grant funds for consultation/documentation visits for federally recognized tribes under Public Law 101-601 of Native American Graves Protection Repatriation Act (NAGPRA); and


WHEREAS, the Native Lands and Resources Department would like to submit a proposal in the amount of \$90,000.00 for the return of sacred objects, cultural patrimony, and unassociated funerary objects at the Springfield Science Museum in Springfield, Massachusetts and the Yale Peabody Museum of Natural History in New Haven, Connecticut; and

WHEREAS, the NPS has a cap on indirect costs at 25% and Central Council's proposed FY 2014 rate is 49.68% which will result in a shortfall of \$11,872.00; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council hereby authorizes the Central Council President or the Chief Operating Officer to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents and contracts that are required from the NPS for granting funds to the Central Council for the proposed grant proposal, and managing funds on behalf of this entity, including any subsequent amendments to the said agreement.

ADOPTED this 22nd day of February 2014, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 6 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 0 absences.
