Resolution EC/14-37

Title: Authorization to Apply for Village Public Safety Officer Program Funding

WHEREAS, Central Council Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) is a federally recognized tribe of more than 29,000 tribal citizens worldwide; and

WHEREAS, public safety in rural Alaska is key to the security, health, and stability of our outlying rural Southeast Alaska communities; and

WHEREAS, the Village Public Safety Officer (VPSO) program has been effective promoting and supporting community safety and stability in smaller villages and communities within Southeast Alaska; and

WHEREAS, Central Council has successfully administered the VPSO program in Southeast Alaska since 2008; and

WHEREAS, the VPSO program has grown from three (3) VPSO positions to eleven (11) stationed in seven Southeast Alaska communities: Angoon, Hydaburg, Kake, Kasaan, Pelican, Saxman, and Thorne Bay; and

WHEREAS, fiscal year 2015 VPSO funding is available through the State of Alaska Department of Public Safety; and

WHEREAS, Central Council wishes to apply for fiscal year 2015 funding in the amount of \$1,717,925;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Executive Council of the Central Council Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes Central Council to apply for fiscal year 2015 funding in the amount of \$1,717,925; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Executive Council hereby authorizes the Central Council President or Chief Operating Officer to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents and contracts that are required from the State of Alaska for granting funds to the Central Council for the proposed Southeast Alaska VPSO Program, and managing funds on behalf of this entity, including any subsequent amendments to the said agreement.


