Resolution EC/ 14-48

Title: Authority to Apply for NAGPRA Travel Grant Funds

WHEREAS, Central Council Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) is a federally recognized tribe of more than 29,000 tribal citizens worldwide; and

WHEREAS, the Native Lands & Resources Department currently has a Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act (NAGPRA) Documentation grant which partially funds the Cultural Resource position; and


WHEREAS, the Native Lands & Resources Department would like to submit a repatriation travel proposal to the National Park Service in the amount of \$15,000.00 for the return of sacred objects from the Virginia Museum of Fine Arts; and

WHEREAS the National Park Service has a cap on indirect costs at 25% and Central Council's FY 2014 rate is 47.67% which will result in a shortfall of \$1,842.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council hereby authorizes the Central Council President or the Chief Operating Officer to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents and contracts that are required from the National Park Service for granting funds to the Central Council for the proposed grant proposal, and managing funds on behalf of this entity, including any subsequent amendments to the said agreement.


