Resolution EC/ 15-09

Title: Authorization to Apply for Native American Graves Protection & Repatriation Act (NAGPRA) Consultation/Documentation Grant Funds

WHEREAS, Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) is a federally recognized tribe of more than 30,000 tribal citizens worldwide; and

WHEREAS, the National Park Service (NPS) has announced the availability of FY 2015 grant funds for consultation/documentation visits at museums for federally recognized tribes under Public Law 101-601 of NAGPRA; and

WHEREAS, the Native Lands & Resources Department would like to submit a proposal in the amount of \$90,000.00 for the return of sacred objects, cultural patrimony, and unassociated funerary objects at the Eiteljorg Museum in Indianapolis, Indiana and the Nelson-Atkins Museum of Art in Kansas City, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the NPS has a cap on indirect costs at 25% and Central Council's approved rate is 37.61% which will result in a shortfall of \$6,598.00; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council hereby authorizes the Central Council President or the Chief Operating Officer to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents and contracts that are required from the National Park Service for granting funds to the Central Council for the proposal, and managing funds on behalf of this entity, including any subsequent amendments to the said agreement.

ADOPTED this 10th day of March 2015, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 6 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 0 absences.
