Resolution EC/ 15-25

Title: Juneau School District, Submitted by Tribal Citizen, Mary Didrickson

WHEREAS, Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) is a federally recognized tribe of more than 30,000 tribal citizens worldwide;

WHEREAS, in 2013 there were 200 homeless Juneau School District students identified and in April 2015 the number of homeless students decreased to 170, with 44% of them being Alaska Native, according to Leslie Scranton, Homeless Coordinator for the Juneau School District

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, Juneau School District Homeless Coordinator, Leslie Scranton is requesting financial support from all Native Corporations in Juneau for students who are homeless now.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Executive Council hereby authorizes the Central Council President or the Chief Operating Officer to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents and contracts that are required from the Native Corporations for granting funds to the Central Council for the proposed, and managing funds on behalf of this entity, including any subsequent amendments to the said agreement.

ADOPTED this 18th day of May 2015, by the Executive Council of the Central Council Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 5 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 1 absence(s).
