Resolution EC/15-43

Title: Confirmation of Citizen Participation for Housing First

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (CCTHITA) is a federally recognized Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska is dedicated to the overall health and wellbeing of its tribal members, including homeless residents; and

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska Tribal Council has the authority to apply for federal, state and local funding to benefit its tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska wishes to receive grant funds under the Department of Housing and Urban Development, Indian Community Development Block Grant (ICDBG); and

WHEREAS, the ICDBG requires compliance with the Citizen Participation Requirement per 24 CFR § 1003.604 (a); and

WHEREAS, the following demonstrates the approach that the CCTHITA took in partnership with Tlingit Haida Housing Authority and Housing First to meet the Citizen Participation Requirement:

- Public notice was given for the City and Borough of Juneau community meeting that was held on January 20th, 2015.
- Housing First has adequately published a meeting announcement and held a meeting at a convenient location and time in order to obtain the views of residents
- Housing First has published a community statement to afford residents an opportunity to examine the funding application contents and submit comments
- Housing First considered all comments and views expressed by residents and tribal members and has appropriately modified the application according to the suggestions and made the modified application available to residents
- The Executive Council of CCTHITA held a meeting on October 13th, 2015 and addressed the project in public comments.

WHEREAS, the due diligence of CCTHITA, by involving and consulting with residents and tribal members, shall not be construed to restrict the responsibility and authority of CCTHITA for the execution of the project; and

WHEREAS, the citizen participation does not include concurrence by any person or group in making final determinations on the contents of the CCTHITA ICDBG program application; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Central Council of Tlingit Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska Executive Council confirms that the Central Council of Tlingit Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska has concurred with the Citizen Participation Requirement per 24 CFR § 1003.604.

ADOPTED this 21th day of October 2015, by the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska by a vote of 4 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 2 absence(s).
