Resolution EC/ 16- 22

Title: Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) Climate Change Adaptation Grant

WHEREAS, Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) is a federally recognized tribe comprised of more than 30,000 tribal citizens worldwide; and

WHEREAS, rapidly changing climate conditions are impacting tribes and change present society with significant economic, health, and safety challenges; and

WHEREAS, the Native Lands and Resource (NLR) department would like to submit a proposal to the BIA in the amount of \$181,947.00 to create a climate change adaptation plan for Southeast Alaska Tribes to use as a template to create a local plan; and

WHEREAS, Central Council's NLR will be creating a position that will last approximately 1.5 years through this funding; and

WHEREAS, the Central Council will work collaboratively with the other Southeast Alaska Tribes to create an adaptation plan that fits the Southeast Alaska region.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Executive Council of the Central Council Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska does hereby authorize the President of Central Council or the Chief Operating Officer to negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents and contracts required for granting the BIA funds to the Central Council Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska and managing funds on behalf of this entity, including any subsequent amendments to said agreement.

ADOPTED this 18th day of May 2016, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 6 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 0 absence(s).
