Resolution EC/ 16-48

Title: Authorization to Partner with Association for Alaska School Boards who will be applying for Funding from U.S. Department of Education

WHEREAS, Central Council Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) is a federally recognized tribe of more than 30,000 tribal citizens worldwide; and

WHEREAS, Central Council will partner with Association of Alaska School Boards (AASB) in its application for funds under the Promise Neighborhoods Program through U.S. Department of Education to improve the welfare of children and youth;

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Promise Neighborhoods Program is to significantly improve the educational and developmental outcomes of children and youth in the most distressed communities;

WHEREAS, other AASB partners include Juneau School District, Hydaburg City Schools, Klawock School District, Department of Education and Early Development, UAS, United Front in POW, and others;

WHEREAS, Central Council's partnership supports efforts that address childcare, nutrition, student success, after school programming, and improvement of high school graduation rates;

WHEREAS, Central Council will establish distance education classes in each of the six communities of Saxman, Klawock, Wrangall, Craig, Haines and Kasaan to improve high school graduation rates with funding for staffing and equipment to be provided through the Promise Neighborhoods Grant for up to \$500K per year for a 60-month project period estimated to begin in Spring 2017, and;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council hereby authorizes CCTHITA to partner with AASB in their grant application to the U.S. Department of Education under the Promise Neighborhoods Program; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Executive Council hereby authorizes Central Council President or Chief Operating Officer to negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents and contracts that are required for accepting funds to the Central Council for the proposed work,

and managing funds on behalf of this entity, including any subsequent amendments to said agreement.

ADOPTED this 7th day of September 2016, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 5 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 1 absence(s).
