To Whom It May Concern:

The Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is seeking individuals who want to be part of a fast paced, dynamic organization to fill two seats on the Tlingit-Haida Regional Housing Authority (THRHA) Board of Commissioners. Candidates are currently being sought from all Tlingit & Haida communities that have designated THRHA as its Tribally Designated Housing Entity under the Native American Housing Assistance and Self Determination Act or those that have THRHA Housing Inventory in their community.

Robust candidates who are committed to housing services and development, have strong communication skills, experience and expertise in analyzing financial reports, regular access to internet in order to be responsive to Board action and meetings are encouraged to apply. Must be able to attend bi-monthly week day board meetings and be available via telephone/email when necessary. Must be willing and able to travel via small planes or commercial airlines or ferries.

Statutory Qualifications:

Per Alaska Statute 18.55.996 Establishment of Regional Housing Authorities, authorization is given to Central Council Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska in the appointment of members to the Tlingit – Haida Regional Housing Authority (THRHA) Board of Commissioners (BOC). THRHA bylaws also define the following for members of the THRHA BOC:

- Should reside in a community that utilizes the Authority as its Tribally Designated Housing Entity (TDHE) under the Native American Housing Assistance and Self Determination Act, only one member of the Board may be from a community not serviced by the TDHE.
- May not be a current employee, vendor or contractor of the Authority, or any business conflict with THRHA.
- Must possess professional or management level career experience with additional consideration given to housing related work experience, banking, real estate, construction management, non-profit leadership, community development finance institutions, finance, legal, business, , tribal or government agency.
- Cannot be a registered sex offender or felon.
- Must be of upstanding moral character.
- Must not have a history of moral turpitude.
