

Job Placement Eligibility Requirements

Job Placement Eligibility Requirements

- Must be tribally enrolled or demonstrate proof of eligibility for tribal enrollment or Certificate of Indian Blood (CIB) from the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
- Must be age 18 or older with a high school diploma or GED certificate.
- Males 18 or older must be registered with Selective Service.
- Job Training placement requires applicants to be unemployed or underemployed (defined as little or no job history and/or limited job skills) and economically disadvantaged.
- Approval of probation/parole officer if on probation.

Communities Served: Craig, Haines, Juneau, Klawock, Pelican, Petersburg, Saxman, Skagway, Tenakee, Thorne Bay, Wrangell

Some communities operate their own BIA funded programs. Tribal citizens residing in Angoon, Douglas, Hoonah, Hydaburg, Kake, Kasaan, Ketchikan, Klukwan, Sitka or Yakutat, must first apply for services through their local IRA offices.
